PURSUANT to the Secondhand Dealers Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

 O R D E R

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Secondhand Dealers Order 1964.
 (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The classes of articles specified in the Schedule to this order are hereby declared to be excluded from the provisions of the Secondhand Dealers Act 1963.
