Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Securities Markets (Disclosure of Relevant Interests by Directors and Officers) Amendment Regulations 2004.

- (2) In these regulations, the Securities Markets (Disclosure of Relevant Interests by Directors and Officers) Regulations 2003¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 27 February 2004.

3 Commencement date of principal regulations amended

Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “1 March 2004”, and substituting the expression “3 May 2004”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 27 February 2004, change the commencement date of the Securities Markets (Disclosure of Relevant Interests by Directors and Officers) Regulations 2003 from 1 March 2004 to 3 May 2004.
