ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 3rd day of February 1964

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Stock Remedies Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

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REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 39 of the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 2 of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and amended by regulation 2 of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 3, and by regulation 2 of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 4, is hereby further amended by adding to subclause (5) the following paragraphs:

“(i) Blackleg/malignant oedema combined vaccine:

“(j) Blackleg/pulpy kidney (entero toxæmia) combined vaccine:

“(k) Blackleg/malignant oedema/pulpy kidney (entero toxæmia) combined vaccine:

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EXPLANATORY NOTE
