ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 27 (2) of the State Sector Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Sector Order (No. 2) 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1991.

2. Ministry of Cultural Affairs—The First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 (as substituted by section 28 (1) of the State Sector Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989) is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Crown Law Office, the following item:

“Ministry of Cultural Affairs”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 January 1991, adds the name of the Ministry of Cultural Affairs to the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988. That Schedule lists the Departments of the Public Service.
