HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Timber Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Timber Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (1), the following subclause:—
- "(1A) These regulations shall be administered by the Commissioner of State Forests."
- 3. The said Regulation 1 is hereby further amended by adding the following words to subclause (2): "For the purposes of these regulations all references in the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939 to the Minister of Supply and Munitions shall be read as references to the Commissioner of State Forests."
- 4. The said Regulation 1 is hereby further amended by inserting in subclause (3), immediately before the definition of the term "proprietor", the following definition:—
 - "' Minister' means the Commissioner of State Forests:".
