PURSUANT to the Tobacco Growing Industry Act 1935, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 16, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Paragraph (b) of regulation 49 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 6) is hereby amended by omitting the words "1,000 lb an acre", and substituting the words "1,250 lb an acre".

3. (1) Regulation 50 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 6, and amended by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 14) is hereby revoked.

(2) The Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 12, and the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 14, are hereby revoked.

4. (1) Paragraph (b) of regulation 51 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 6) is hereby revoked.

(2) Regulation 51 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (c), and substituting the following paragraph.

“(c) The estimated capacity of all kilns used by the grower:”.

5. (1) Paragraph (b) of subclause (1) of regulation 59 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 8 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 4, and amended by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 11) is hereby further amended by omitting the words “6s. an hour”, and substituting the words “8s. an hour”.

(2) The Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 11, are hereby revoked.

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#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations revoke provisions of the principal regulations which specify, by reference to prescribed kiln capacity, the number of pounds of flue cured leaf which a grower could reasonably be expected to cure in a season.

The regulations also increase, from 6s. to 8s. an hour, the amount payable to panel assessors.
