**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

**THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licenses Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licenses Emergency Regulations 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding the following regulation :—

“10. In exercising the powers conferred on him by section 82 of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1941, the Governor-General may make an appointment to the office of Transport Appeal Authority to have effect on and after a date named therein, notwithstanding that that date may be prior to the date when the appointment is made. It is hereby declared that any such appointment shall be as valid and effective for all purposes as if it had been made on the earlier date.”
