**THE TAURANGA MILK DISTRICT ORDER 1956**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of September 1956

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Tauranga Milk District Order 1956.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Tauranga Milk District, as constituted by the Tauranga Milk District Constitution Order 1954,\* shall hereafter consist of the Borough of Tauranga, as constituted from time to time, and those parts of the County of Tauranga described in the Schedule hereto.

3. The Tauranga Borough Council shall continue to be the Milk Authority of the said district.

4. The Tauranga County Council shall be entitled to have one representative on the Milk Committee of the Tauranga Borough Council and from time to time may nominate a person for that purpose.

5. The Tauranga Borough Council shall from time to time appoint to the Milk Committee of the Borough Council the person nominated by the Tauranga County Council pursuant to clause 4 hereof.

6. This order is in substitution for the Tauranga Milk District Constitution Order 1954,\* and that order is hereby revoked.

## SCHEDULE

## PARTS OF TAURANGA COUNTY INCLUDED IN TAURANGA MILK DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Tauranga County, in the South Auckland Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in Block XIII, Tauranga Survey District, on the right bank of the Wairoa River, being the northernmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. 24309, being part Allotment 74, Te Papa Parish, and running generally north-easterly, easterly, and then southerly down that right bank and along the shores of the Tauranga Harbour to and along the northern and eastern boundaries of the Borough of Tauranga, as described in the *Gazette* of the 20th day of April 1950, Vol. I, page 472, and continuing along the shores of the Tauranga Harbour to the southern side of the Paeroa-Whakatane State Highway in Block XV of the aforesaid Survey District; thence south-westerly generally along that side of the said highway to and along the eastern, southern, and western boundaries of the land subdivided and shown on D.P.(s) 1459, and again along the southern side of that highway to and up the left bank of the Kaitimako Stream to and along the northern boundary of Lot 6, D.P. 14524, being part Ohauti No. 2 Block, to and along the eastern side of Ohauti Road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Lot 2, D.P.(s) 2671, being part Ohauti No. 2 Block aforesaid; thence westerly along a right line to and along the southern and western boundaries of the said Lot 2, the southern and western boundaries of Lot 3, D.P.(s) 924, and the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 36592, being parts Ohauti No. 2 Block aforesaid, to and along the southern side of the public road forming the northern boundary of the southern part of Lot 1, D.P. 5137, being part of the aforesaid No. 2 Block, and the northern boundaries of Poeke Nos. 3A, 3B, part 6A 3, 6B 2A, and 6B 2B Blocks, and along a right line being that southern side produced across the Waimapu River and Oropi Road to the generally southern side of the road forming the north-western boundary of Allotment 51, Te Papa Parish; thence along that side of the road which also forms the northern boundary of Allotment 50, the north-eastern boundary of Allotment 47, and the eastern and northern boundaries of part Allotment 46 to and along a right line being the last-mentioned roadside produced to the western side of the Rotorua-Tauranga (Direct) Main Highway; thence north-westerly along that side of the said highway to and along the north-eastern boundary of Allotment 22, along the south-eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Lot 4, D.P.(s) 3678, being part Allotment 527, and along the south-eastern boundary of Lot 3, D.P.(s) 3678 aforesaid, being the south-eastern bank of the Kopureroa Stream Diversion Cut, to and along the northern boundary of the said Lot 3, along the northern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 36411, being parts of Allotments 526, 83, and 78, the aforesaid allotments being of Te Papa Parish, and along a right line being that northern boundary produced across Cambridge Road to the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 24309, being part Allotment 74 of the aforesaid parish, and along the eastern and northern boundaries of the said Lot 1 to the point of commencement.

Also all that area in the Tauranga County, in the South Auckland Land District, bounded by a line commencing at the southernmost corner of Omanu No. 2K Block and running south-easterly along the southern boundary of the Borough of Mount Maunganui, as described in the *Gazette* of the 5th day of August 1954, Vol. II, page 1266, to a point

in line with the north-western boundary of Papamoa No. 2 No. 10 Block; thence southerly along a right line to and along that north-western boundary to and westerly and northerly along the shores of the Tauranga Harbour to the point of commencement.
