PURSUANT to subsection (3) of section 21 of the Industries and Commerce Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Timber Preservation Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Timber Preservation Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to subclause (2) the following paragraph:

“(1) One member who shall be appointed on the nomination of the New Zealand Wood Preservers’ Association Incorporated.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations vary the constitution of the Timber Preservation Authority by providing for it to include a member appointed on the nomination of the New Zealand Wood Preservers’ Association Incorporated.
