Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 8.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1945.
- 4. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations, as substituted by the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937,* Amendment No. 5, and Regulation 4 of the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6, is amended by inserting, before the word "Mangamingi", the words "Little Waipa (from Pearce's Falls to its mouth), and the tributaries of the Little Waipa having their confluence with the river in that portion thereof which lies between Pearce's Falls and its mouth".
