**THE TROUT-FISHING (WELLINGTON) REGULATIONS 1941
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of
August, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1945.

4. Clause (b) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended as follows :—

(1) By inserting, after item (6) thereof, the following item :—

“(6A) The Mangatainoka River below the Main Road Bridge at Mangatainoka.”

(2) By revoking items (5) and (12), and substituting the following items respectively :—

“(5) The Manawatu River below its junction with the Mangatainoka River.”

“(12) The Rangitikei River below the Otara Bridge at Ohingaiti.”

5. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is revoked.

6. Clause (b) of Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended as follows :—

- (1) By revoking in item (12) the words “ from its source to the Main Road Bridge at Newman ” ; in item (21) the words “ from its source to the Main North Road Bridge ” ; and in item (32) the words “ from its source to the railway-bridge ”.
- (2) By revoking item (15A), as inserted by paragraph (1) of Regulation 6 of the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1,* and substituting the following item :—

“(15A) The Mangatainoka River from its source to its junction with the Makakahi River.”
