HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 3.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1946.
4. Clause (a) of Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "half an ounce", and substituting the words "one ounce".
