THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS 1956, AMENDMENT NO. 11

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 12th day of August 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 11, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Traffic Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term "traffic officer", and substituting the following definition:

"Traffic officer" means a traffic officer who is an officer of the Transport Department or of a local authority; and includes any other person whose appointment as a traffic officer is approved by the Minister:".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the definition of traffic officer by including officers appointed by any local authority. Previously, only a City Council could appoint traffic officers.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 13 August 1964.

These regulations are administered in the Transport Department.
