**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Telephone Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Telephone Regulations 1961\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1964.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Division 3 of Part I (milage charges) of the First Schedule and substituting the following:

*“Division 3—Milage Charges (Reg. 31)*

(Applicable to main station connections beyond the boundary of a base rate area or special rate area)

For an individual line	..... 0	17	6	per furlong or part for the first 5 miles; 10s. a furlong thereafter.
For a two-party line	..... 0	8	9	per furlong or part for the first 5 miles; 5s. a furlong thereafter.
For a three-party line	..... 0	4	0	per furlong or part for the first 5 miles; 10s. a mile thereafter.
For a four-party line	..... 0	3	6	per furlong or part for the first 5 miles; 10s. a mile thereafter.
For a five-party line	..... 1	5	0	a mile for the first 3 miles; 10s. a mile thereafter up to and including 20 miles; 6s. 3d. a mile thereafter.
For a six-party to 10-party line	..... 1	0	0	a mile for the first 3 miles; 10s. a mile thereafter up to and including 20 miles; 6s. 3d. a mile thereafter.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations fix new milage charges in respect of telephones in outer areas.
