



**THE TAUPO TROUT-FISHING REGULATIONS 1939,  
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 26th day of  
September, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, and section 14 of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Taupo Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Taupo Trout-fishing Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1945.

4. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, next following clause 4 thereof, the following clause :—

“(4A) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) of the Special Act, no person shall fish for, take, or kill in any manner whatever or intentionally have in his possession any smelt (*Retropinna lacustris*) or kokopu (*Galaxias fasciatus*) or the ova, young, or fry of any smelt or kokopu in any stage whatever.”

5. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is further amended by revoking the words “in the last preceding clause hereof” in clause (5), and substituting the words “in clauses (4) and (4A) hereof”.

6. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking clause (5), and substituting the following clause :—

“(5) No person shall fish for trout from the Taupo Wharf or Taupo Boat Jetty or from the control bridge crossing the Waikato River near Taupo township.”

7. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is further amended by inserting, next following clause (5) thereof, the following clause:—

“(5A) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these regulations or contained in any license issued under these regulations, no person shall during the period commencing on the 1st day of November, 1945, and terminating on the 14th day of May, 1948, fish for, take, or kill trout by any means whatsoever in or from the Waihukahuka Stream (Hatchery Stream) and that portion of the Tongariro River within a radius of 50 yards shore to shore from the centre of the meeting-line of the said stream and river.”
