



Veterinarians (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2004

Pursuant to section 72(1)(a) of the Veterinarians Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Veterinarians (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Veterinarians (Fees) Regulations 1999¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Schedule amended

- (1) The Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from the second column of item 5 the expression “2,800.00”, and substituting the expression “3,100.00”.
- (2) The Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from the second column of item 7 the expression “787.50”, and substituting the expression “1,400.00”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Veterinarians (Fees) Regulations 1999.

The amendments increase the fee payable for—

- the final examination from \$2,800 to \$3,100;
- specialist registration from \$787.50 to \$1,400.

The fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
