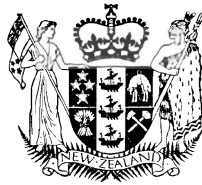

THE VISITING FORCES ORDER 1964

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 6th day of April 1964

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Visiting Forces Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Visiting Forces Order 1964.

2. (1) Each of the following countries is hereby declared to be part of the Commonwealth for the purposes of the Visiting Forces Act 1939:

The United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, India, Pakistan, Ceylon, Ghana, Malaysia, Nigeria, Cyprus, Sierra Leone, Tanganyika, Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Zanzibar, and Kenya.

(2) Each of the following countries is hereby declared to be part of the Commonwealth for the purposes of the Visiting Forces Act 1939 as if it were a member of the Commonwealth:

The Republic of Ireland and Western Samoa.

3. The Visiting Forces Order 1961* is hereby revoked.
