THE RIGHT HON. D. MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 44 (2) (c) of the Valuers Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Valuers Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Valuers Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Subject to regulation 2 (2) of these regulations, these regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of the First Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee payable for an annual practising certificate issued in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of December 1980 shall be \$10.

3. Revocation—The Valuers Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 3 are hereby consequentially revoked.

"1. On application for registration	\$35.00
"2. For a certificate of registration	No charge
"3. For a duplicate certificate of registration	\$5.00
"4. For a certified copy of any entry in the Register	\$2.00
"5. On application for restoration of name to the Register after removal for any reason	\$10.00
"6. On application for any alteration or addition to an entry in the Register other than the correction of any errors in publication	\$2.00
"7. For inspection of the Register	\$2.00
"8. For an annual practising certificate	\$20.00
"9. For a certificate of the particulars entered on any one annual practising certificate	\$2.00"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fees payable under the Valuers Regulations 1949. The increases take effect 14 days after notification in the *Gazette*, although the fee payable for an annual practising certificate in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 December 1980) remains at \$10.
