



**THE VETERINARY SURGEONS REGULATIONS 1958,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 9th day of February 1981

PURSUANT to the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Subject to regulation 2 (2) of these regulations, these regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Annual practising fee—(1) Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3) (as added by regulation 2 of the Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(3) The fee payable for a certificate under section 32A of the Act shall be \$15.”

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 5 (3) of the principal regulations (as substituted by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee payable for a certificate issued under section 32A of the Act in respect of the whole or part of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1981 shall be \$2.10.

3. Revocation—The Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fee payable by a veterinary surgeon for an annual practising certificate. The fee is increased from \$2.10 to \$15 although the fee payable for a practising certificate issued in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 March 1981) remains at \$2.10.
