At the Government House at Wellington, this 31st day of October, 1945

PURSUANT to section 30 of the War Legislation Act, 1917, as extended by section 17 of the Finance Act (No. 4), 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the War Bursaries Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Bursaries Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of

February, 1946.

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By omitting at the end of paragraph (b) of clause 4 the word "or":

(b) By revoking paragraph (c) of clause 4:

(c) By omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (2) of clause 8 the reference to "£5", and substituting a reference to "£25":

(d) By revoking paragraph (c) of subclause (2) of clause 8:

(e) By omitting from subclause (2) of clause 9 the words "or the Registrar of the college":

(f) By omitting the words "or college" wherever they occur in subclause (2) of clause 5, from subclause (2) and paragraph (b) of subclause (3) of clause 8, and from subclause (2) of clause 10.
