# THE WOOL LEVY REGULATIONS 1945

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 1st day of August, 1945

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Industry Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Levy Regulations 1945.

2. The Wool Levy Regulations 1936 are revoked.

3. In these regulations the term "the said Act" means the Wool Industry Act, 1944.

4. The maximum rates of the levy that may be charged on wool pursuant to section 12 of the said Act shall be—

(a) For each bale, 2s.

(b) For each fadge, 1s.

(c) For each bag or sack, 4d.

5. The return and declaration by a wool-manufacturer to be made pursuant to section 16 of the said Act shall be in or to the effect of the form set forth in the Schedule hereto.
