# THE WHEAT RESEARCH REGULATIONS 1954, AMENDMENT NO. 3

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 17 of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Wheat Research Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wheat Research Regulations 1954\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Wheat Research Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended as follows:
  - (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the words "rate of 5d.", and substituting the words "rate of 6d.":
  - (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the words "rate of 5d.", and substituting the words "rate of 6d.":
  - (c) By omitting from paragraph (c) the words "rate of 5d.", and substituting the words "rate of 6d.".
- 3. Paragraph (a) of regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word "purchaser", and substituting the word "producer".

4. The Wheat Research Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 2, are hereby revoked.

These regulations increase, from 5d. to 6d., the rate of levy imposed in respect of wheat research.
