In the Wellington Industrial District (No. 2).—In the matter of an industrial dispute between the Wellington branch of the Federated Seamen's Union and J. H. Cock and Co., of Nelson; W. and G. Turnbull and Co., of Wellington; C. W. Turner, of Christchurch; and Levin and Co., of Wellington.

At a meeting of the Board of Conciliation, held this 8th day of April, 1897, at which a letter was read from Mr. A. H. Turnbull to the Chairman, enclosing a copy of objections to the report and recommendations already filed herein, Mr. Jones, the secretary of the Wellington branch of the Federated Seamen's Union being present, was shown the objections, and it appearing that no compromise could be arrived at with regard to the said objections the Board therefore report that they have been unable to bring about any settlement of the dispute referred to them satisfactory to the parties thereto.
