(26.) DUNEDIN LINOTYPISTS.

A CONFERENCE between the parties concerned was held with the members of the Arbitration Court present, and the Typographical Union agreed to accept the conditions ruling in Christchurch and Wellington under the respective agreements between the employers and unions in those cities.

An agreement was therefore drawn up by the President of the Court accordingly, and it is to remain in force until the 31st December next (1899).
