

(28.) DUNEDIN TAILORESSES.

THIS agreement, made in pursuance of "The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1894," this 17th day of April, 1899, between Louis Warsaw, of Dunedin, master tailor, and the Dunedin Tailoresses' Industrial Union of Workers, whereby the parties agree to abide by the statement of wages and conditions of labour as per award of the Court of Arbitration.
