

(1162.) WELLINGTON DRIVERS.—ADDING PARTIES TO SUPPLEMENTARY AWARD FOR WANGANUI.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of “The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1905,” and its amendments; and in the matter of a supplementary award for Wanganui to that of the 29th November, 1904, in force in the City of Wellington between the Wellington Drivers’ Industrial Union of Workers and the employers.
