

(1029.) GISBORNE PAINTERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Arbitration Court, Northern District.—In the matter of the Gisborne Painters and Decorators award.

THIS Court having had an application to amend, with the consent of all parties, the award made the 18th day of July, 1905 (Book of Awards, Vol. vi, p. 158), between the Gisborne Painters and Decorators' Industrial Union of Workers and the employers therein named, and being satisfied that by an inadvertance an error has been made in the drawing-up of the said award, hereby orders that the same be amended by substituting for clause 9 thereof the following clause :—

“9. Overtime shall be paid for at the following rates : Time and a quarter to be paid from 6 a.m. to 7.45 a.m. ; time and a quarter from 5 p.m. to 10 p.m. ; time and a half from 10 p.m. to 12 p.m. ; double time from midnight to 6 a.m. on ordinary workdays, and from 12.15 p.m. on Saturdays. Three-quarters of an hour to be allowed for dinner between 12 and 1 o'clock.”
