

(1193.) WELLINGTON CARPENTERS AND JOINERS. — EXEMPTION  
FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration, Wellington Industrial District (Wellington).—In the matter of “The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1905,” and its amendments, and in the matter of an award dated the 14th November, 1906, between the Wellington Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters’ and Joiners’ Industrial Union of Workers and the employers therein named, and in the matter of an application by the Vacuum Oil Company of Wellington for exemption from the provisions thereof.

THIS Court, being satisfied that the Vacuum Oil Company of Wellington, the above-named applicant, was at the hearing of the dispute exempted from the operation of the said award, doth hereby order that the said award be amended by striking out the name of the said company as a party thereto, and that the said company be and the same is hereby declared to be exempt from the provisions of the said award.
