

MARLBOROUGH INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(1330.) MARLBOROUGH LABOURERS.—APPLICATION FOR AWARD.

THE Marlborough Labourers' Union applied for an award, but as the union had not complied with the procedure laid down in sections 105 and 106 of "The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1905" (providing for a ballot of all the members of the union), in citing the employers, the Court had no jurisdiction, and the case was thrown out. (4th July, 1907.)
