
(1386.) CHRISTCHURCH HAIRDRESSERS AND TOBACCONISTS'
ASSISTANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the award, dated the 19th day of December, 1906, in the dispute between the Christchurch Hairdressers and 'Tobacconists' Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers and the employers therein named.

ORDER OF THE COURT AMENDING AWARD.

THE Court being satisfied that the following provision was accidentally omitted from the agreement of the parties, dated the 28th day of June, 1906, and from the said award, and such provision having been consented to by all the parties, doth hereby order that the said award be amended by the insertion of the following addition to clause 7:—

“ *Partial Holidays.*—Boxing Day, from 11 o'clock in the forenoon.”
