

CANTERBURY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(1655.) CHRISTCHURCH GENERAL LABOURERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of “The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908”; and in the matter of an award made on the 13th day of July, 1908, in an industrial dispute between the Christchurch General Labourers’ Industrial Union of Workers and — Allen and other employers.

TUESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1908.

FOR the purpose of giving fuller effect to the said award, and by consent of the parties, this Court doth order that the said award shall be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following words at the end of clause 1 of the said award:—

“In the Town of Ashburton ‘Thursday’ shall be substituted for ‘Saturday’ for the purposes of the foregoing clause.”
