

(2195.) POVERTY BAY FREEZING-WORKS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award made on the 30th day of July, 1910, in an industrial dispute between the Gisborne Sheep-farmers' Frozen Meat Company (Limited) and Nelson Bros. (Limited) and the Poverty Bay Freezing-works Industrial Union of Workers.

MONDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1910.

UPON the application of the above-named union, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that clause 7 of the said award shall be and the same is hereby amended by adding "the birthday of the reigning sovereign" to the list of days to be observed as holidays.
