APPLICATION by the Workers' Union to amend the award (Vol. xi, p. 207) by adding the words "Moeraki and Oamaru" to end of clause 8.

Application by the employers to amend clause 1 to read, "The week's work shall not exceed seventy hours, subject to the following condition: When more than seventy hours are worked in any one week, overtime at the rates hereinafter specified shall be paid"; to delete in clause 4 the words "beyond twelve hours in any one day"; and to add in clause 2, subclauses (a), (b), and (c), the words "at the rate of" after the word "paid."

Both applications refused.
