

(2215.) CANTERBURY TANNERS, FELLMONGERS, AND SKINNERS.  
—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award made on the 20th day of March, 1908, in an industrial dispute between the Canterbury Tanners, Fellmongers, and Skinners' Industrial Union of Workers and W. H. Alstead and the other employers therein named.

TUESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1910.

UPON the application of the above-named union, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award shall be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following clause to the said award:—

(11A.) A similar employment-book shall be kept in the office of the Inspector of Factories at Ashburton, in which shall be entered the names and exact addresses of all the members of the union for the time being out of employment in or about the Town of Ashburton, with a description of the branch of the trade in which each such member claims to be proficient. All the provisions of clause 11 of the said award shall apply to the said book, with this modification: that when the said book has been established, notice thereof by advertisement shall be published in the *Ashburton Guardian* newspaper.”
