

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(2073.) DUNEDIN CARTERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration, New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of “The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908,” and its amendment; and in the matter of an award dated the 22nd day of December, 1909, and made between the Dunedin and Suburban Carters’ Industrial Union of Workers and the employers therein named.

MONDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1910.

IN order to remedy a defect in the said award, and to give fuller effect to the agreement of the parties which was embodied therein, the Court doth hereby order that the said award be amended as follows:—

(1.) That clause 9 be amended by adding thereto “Labour Day” as one of the recognised holidays.

(2.) That the following clause be substituted for clause 16 of the said award: “Should any matter arise during the currency of this award which has not been provided for, such matter shall be arranged between the employers’ union and the workers’ union, and, in default of agreement between them, shall be settled by the Inspector of Awards.”
