(2142.) CANTERBURY UNITED FURNITURE TRADES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendment; and in the matter of an award bearing date the 4th day of October, 1909, made in an industrial dispute between the Christchurch United Furniture Trades Industrial Union of Workers and Adair and Schiffer and other employers.

WEDNESDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF JULY, 1910.

UPON the application of the above-named union, and with the consent of the employers in the Town of Ashburton, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award shall be, and the same is, hereby amended by adding the following words at the end of clause 1 thereof: "In the Town of Ashburton the hours shall be eight hours per day on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday, and four hours on Thursday, finishing at 12 o'clock noon."
