

## CANTERBURY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(2156.) CANTERBURY FREEZING-WORKS, BACON, AND MANURE EMPLOYEES.—ORDER AMENDING AWARDS *RE* AMALGAMATION OF UNIONS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendment; and in the matter of the following awards made in connection with industrial disputes: The Canterbury Freezers' Industrial Union of Workers, Award No. 1377; the Canterbury Slaughtermen's Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers, Award No. 2109; the Canterbury Manure, Tallow, Oleo, and Freezing-works Labourers' Industrial Union of Workers, Award No. 1739; the Canterbury Meat-preservers' Industrial Union of Workers, Award No. 1379 and Award No. 1484.

ALL the above-named unions having desired to amalgamate so as to form one union, and having taken steps to carry out such desire by registering a new industrial union under the name of the Canterbury Freezing-works, Bacon, and Manure Employees' Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union"), and application having been made to this Court for an order under section 20 of the above-mentioned Act, it is ordered that the said awards shall be and the same are hereby amended by substituting the new union as a party to the said awards in lieu respectively of the above-named unions.
