(2455.) SOUTH CANTERBURY PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.— AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 14th day of March, 1910, made in an industrial dispute between the Timaru Society of Painters and Decorators' Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") and J. Allen, painter, Geraldine, and the other employers mentioned therein.

Tuesday, the 21st day of November, 1911.

In order to remedy a defect in the said award, and to give fuller effect to the agreement of the parties which were embodied therein, this Court doth order that the clauses 4 and 9 of the said award be amended as follows: (1) By inserting in clause 4, after the words "Boxing Day," "and Saturdays from 12 noon"; (2) by deleting from clause 9 the words "Saturdays excepted."
