

(2456.) CANTERBURY PRINTERS' MACHINISTS AND BOOKBINDERS.
—ORDER AMENDING AWARDS *RE* AMALGAMATION OF UNIONS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the following awards made in connection with industrial disputes: The Canterbury Lithographic and Letterpress Printers Machinists' Industrial Union of Workers (Award No. 2273); the Christchurch Bookbinders and Paper-rulers' Industrial Union of Workers (Award No. 1350).

Tuesday, the 21st day of November, 1911.

BOTH the above-named unions having desired to amalgamate so as to form one union, and having taken steps to carry out such desire by registering a new industrial union under the name of "The Canterbury Printers' Machinists and Bookbinders' Industrial Union of Workers" (hereinafter called "the union"), and application having been made to this Court for an order under section 20 of the above-mentioned Act, it is ordered that the said awards shall be and the same are hereby amended by substituting the new union as a party to the said awards in lieu respectively of the above-named unions.
