**(2310.) MANAWATU FLAXMILLS EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award made on the 16th day of March, 1910, in an industrial dispute between the Manawatu Flax-mills Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and Bell and Co. and the other employers therein named.

Tuesday, the 4th Day of April, 1911.

FOR the purpose of remedying a defect in the above-mentioned award, this Court doth order that the said award shall be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following words at the end of subclause (b) of clause 1 thereof: "Work of every kind after 1 p.m. on Saturday is prohibited, save where necessary for the purpose of saving property from destruction by fire, flood, or otherwise."
