(2311.) NEW ZEALAND FEDERATED BOOT TRADE.—ORDER EXTENDING AWARD *RE* FEMALE OPERATIVES TO TARANAKI INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award made on the 12th day of June, 1909, in the Canterbury Industrial District, in an industrial dispute between the New Zealand Federated Boot Trade Association and the New Zealand Boot Manufacturers' Industrial Union of Employers.

Friday, the 31st Day of March, 1911.

UPON the application of the above-named association, and upon hearing the representative of the said association and Hal Goodacre, the proprietor and manager of the Egmont Boot and Shoe Company, this Court doth order that the above-mentioned award shall and the same is hereby extended to the Taranaki Industrial District so as to bind the said Egmont Boot and Shoe Company, but so that the provisions of clause 1 of the said award shall not apply to any workers now employed by the said company.
