

(2347.) WELLINGTON SADDLERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 24th day of March, 1911, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington Saddlers' Industrial Union of Workers and W. Hill, Taranaki Street, Wellington, and the other employers therein named.

Tuesday, the 27th day of June, 1911.

UPON reading an application by the above-named union, filed herein on the 27th day of May, 1911, and upon hearing such of the parties as were represented, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by the following additions being made:—

To collar-makers' price-list—

Yankee collars.

Yankee collar, pipe, thonged or welted, single or double,
7s. 6d.

Yankee collar, round, thonged or welted, single or
double, 7s. 6d.

Yankee collar to be cut out by workmen.

To riding-saddle price-list—

No. 2 stock, stitching to be done by employer.

Common stock klondyke, stitching to be done by employer.

Lady's astride saddles in all qualities, same price as gent's.
