

(2359.) OTAGO BRICKLAYERS.—ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award made on the 20th day of December, 1910, in an industrial dispute between the Otago Bricklayers' Industrial Union of Workers and Henry Abbott and the other employers named therein.

Wednesday, the 17th Day of May, 1911.

UPON the application of the above-named union, and upon hearing the parties, this Court doth order that the Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board shall be and is hereby added as a party to the said award, with this modification: that the said Board shall not be bound to pay more than 1s. 6d. per hour for any work done by bricklayers in connection with the construction of manholes in sewers and of gully-shafts in streets.
