(2535.) TIMARU CARPENTERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 12th day of December, 1910, made in an industrial dispute between the Timaru Carpenters' Industrial Union of Workers and William Andrews and other employers.

Friday, the 19th Day of April, 1912.

Upon the application of the above-named union, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following words at the end of clause 10, subclause (c), thereof:—

"It may also be arranged on country jobs for the work to be done on the holidays mentioned in clause 5 hereof, if mutually agreed, at ordinary rates for country work; provided always that all work done on Sundays shall be paid for at the rate of double time."
