

(2936.) CHRISTCHURCH AND TIMARU ELECTRICAL WORKERS.—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award made on the 20th day of June, 1913, in an industrial dispute between the Canterbury Electrical Workers' Industrial Union of Workers and Brown Bros. and other employers (Book of Awards, Vol. xiv, p. 438).

Friday, the 19th day of September, 1913.

FOR the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award this Court doth order that the said award be amended and the same is hereby amended by adding the following words to clause 12 thereof: "Nothing herein contained shall prevent an employer from employing any person who is a member of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers although he is not a member of the union."
