AMENDING AWARDS *RE* AMALGAMATION OF UNIONS.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland Furniture Trades award dated the 5th day of April, 1913, and numbered 219, and the Auckland Rattan and Wicker-workers' award dated the 3rd day of September, 1913, and numbered 315.
