(2976.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND COACHWORKERS AND WHEEL-WRIGHTS.—ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 9th day of November, 1912, in an industrial dispute between the Otago Coachworkers and Wheelwrights' Industrial Union of Workers and Reid and Gray (Limited) and others in the said award named.
