

(2843.) OTAGO TIMBERYARDS AND SAWMILLS.—ADDING PARTY
TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 10th day of July, 1912, made in an industrial dispute between the Otago Timberyards and Sawmills' Industrial Union of Workers and S. Aburn and Sons and other employers.
