

(3931.) SHEARERS (GISBORNE, WELLINGTON, MARLBOROUGH, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND).—AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENTS.

In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an industrial agreement between the New Zealand Sheepowners and Farmers' Federation (for and on behalf of the Poverty Bay and East Coast Sheepowners' Industrial Union of Employers, the Hawke's Bay Sheepowners' Industrial Union of Employers, the Marlborough Sheepowners' Industrial Union of Employers, the Canterbury Sheepowners' Industrial Union of Employers, and the Otago and Southland Sheepowners' Industrial Union of Employers) and the New Zealand Shearers and Woolshed Employees' Industrial Association of Workers (for and on behalf of themselves and the Gisborne Shearers and Shed Hands' Industrial Union of Workers, the Wellington Shearers' Industrial Union of Workers, the Marlborough Shearers' Industrial Union of Workers, the Canterbury Shearers' Industrial Union of Workers, and the Otago and Southland Shearers' Industrial Union of Workers).
