

(3983.) AUCKLAND TAILORS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 7th day of April, 1914, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Tailors' Industrial Union of Workers and the Auckland Importing Company and others.

Monday, the 23rd day of November, 1914.

For the purpose of remedying defects in the said award this Court doth order that the said award be and it is hereby amended as follows:—

Machine log (p. 329): The rate to be deducted by the employer if the work is done by the machinist shall be 1s. 1½d. per hour—*i.e.*, one-eighth increase on the rate fixed by the said award.

Ladies' log (p. 331): The words "Time statement of one shilling per hour" is deleted, and in lieu thereof the words "Time statement of one shilling and one penny halfpenny per hour" are inserted.
